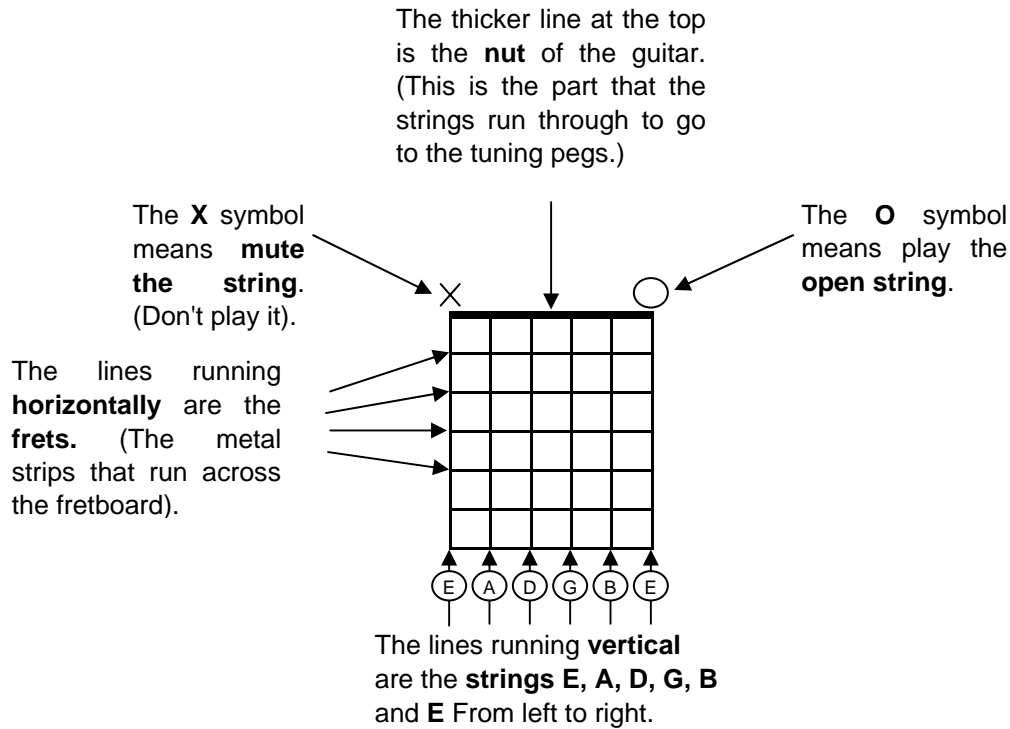


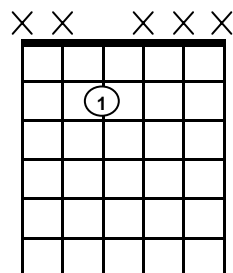
How To Read Chord Boxes



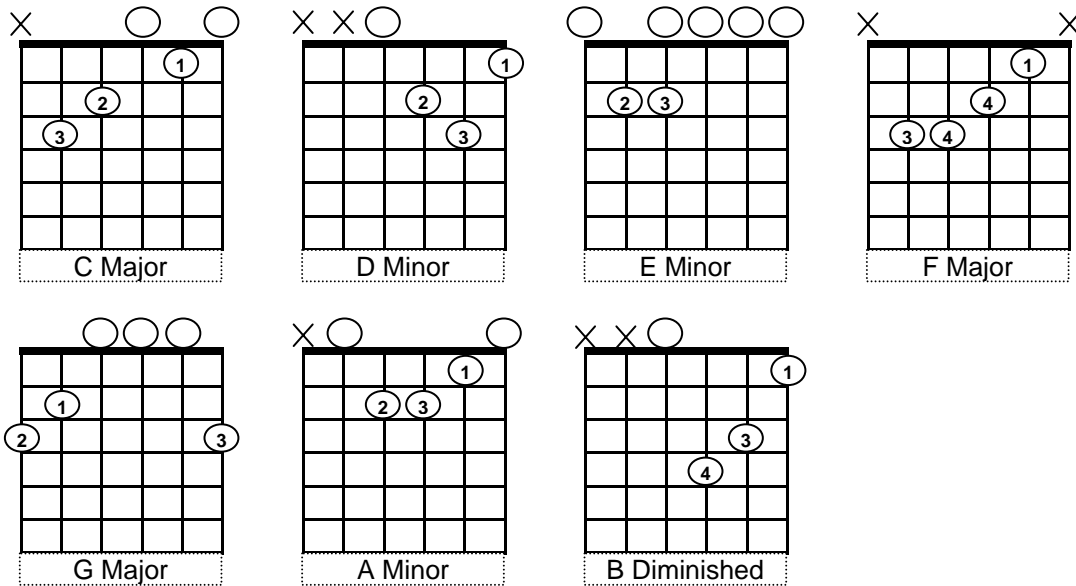
Each finger on the fretting hand is assigned a number 1, 2, 3 or 4.

①	— First Finger	— Index Finger
②	— Second Finger	— Middle Finger
③	— Third Finger	— Ring Finger
④	— Fourth Finger	— Pinky

This diagram tells you that you should play the second fret on the D string with the first or index finger and not play the other strings.



Basic Chords



These are the 7 chords taken from the C major scale. There are other ways of playing these chords but these are the most basic as the fingerings are simple and easy to play.

These chords are referred to as **open chords** as they use open strings to play some of the notes.
